Since the summer of 2022, fertiliser producers, traders and farmers have had to comply with the EU Fertiliser Products Regulation, which has significantly changed CE marking rules and labelling requirements for fertilisers. With the new regulation, it is now possible to market a very wide range of fertilisers within the EU, including organic fertilisers, organo-mineral fertilisers, growing media or biostimulants, provided they meet all applicable environmental and safety requirements.
